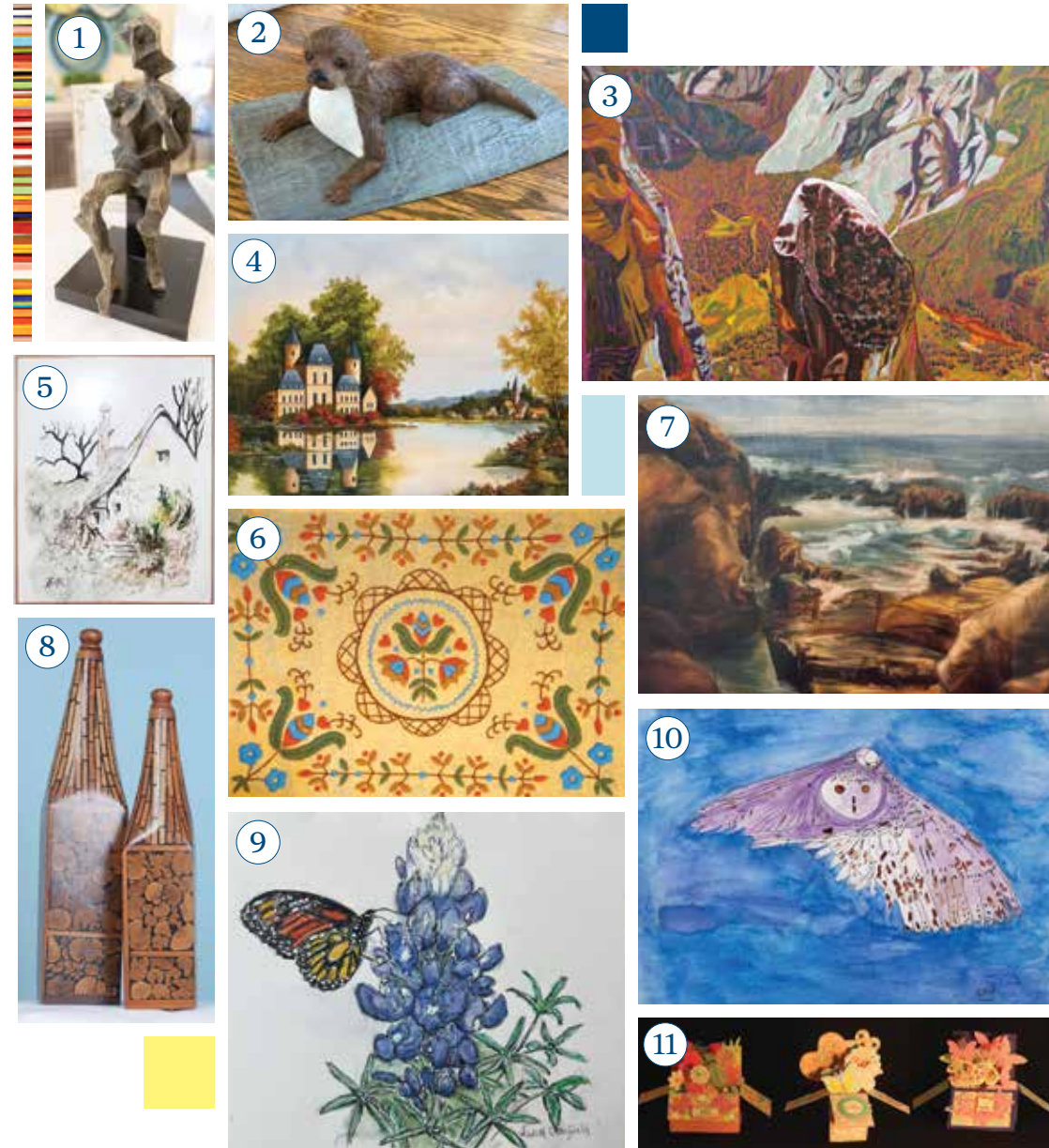

DIRECTIONS

1. Cut peppers into 2-inch pieces (if you don't want the pepper's top spicy, remove seeds before frying).

4. Add chopped garlic, and rosemary.

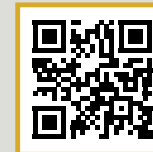
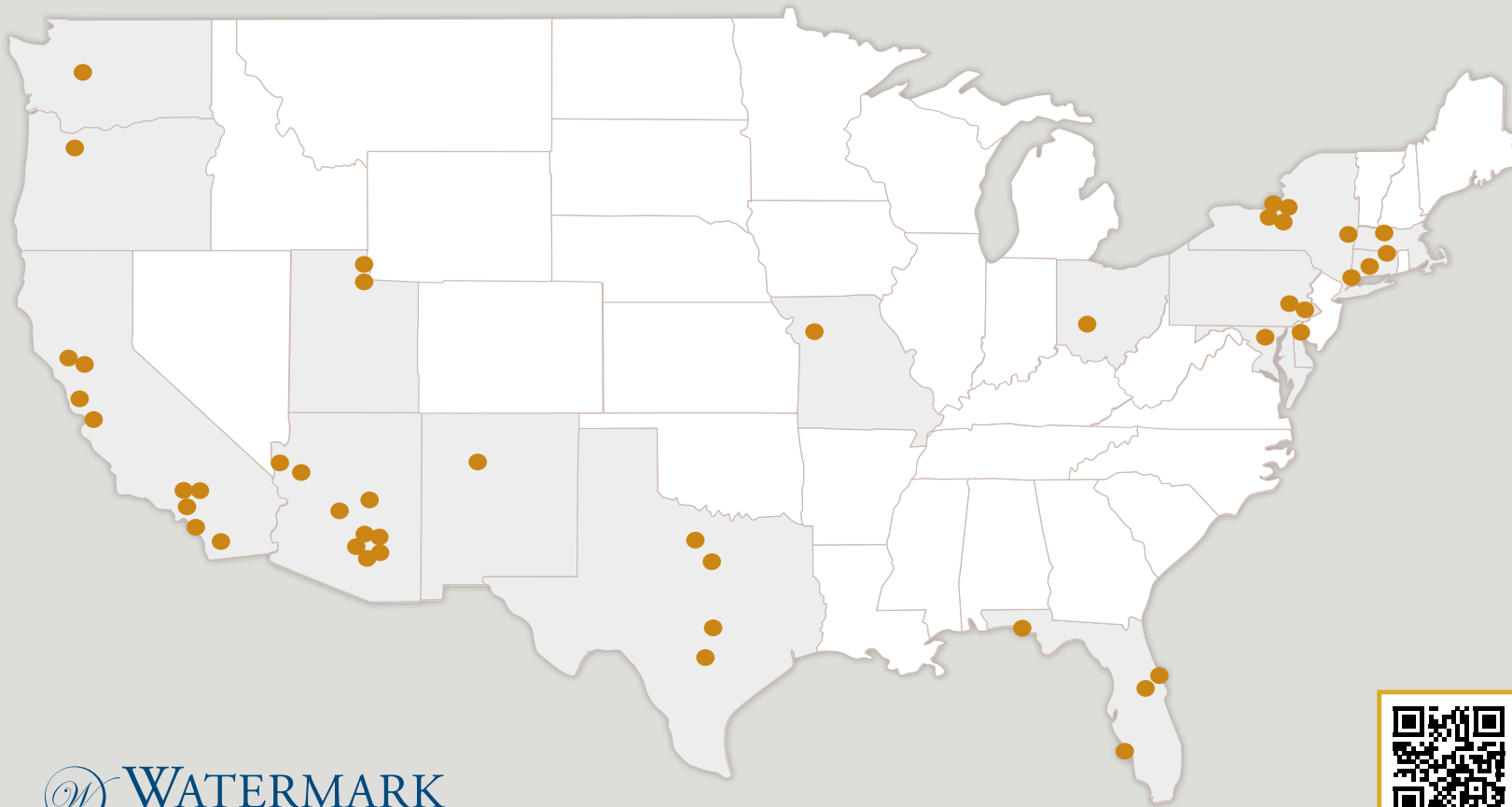
